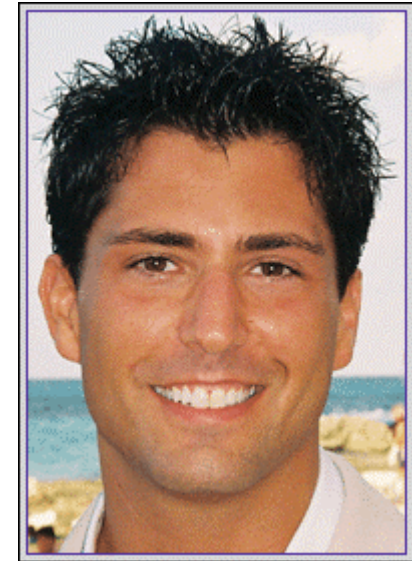
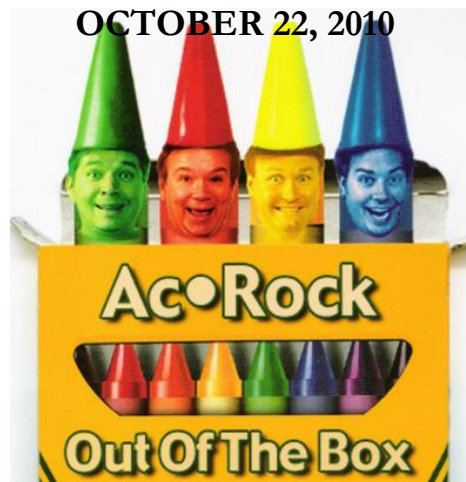

AC Rock consists of four men who sing a cappella rock'n roll. Starting their 15th year signing at schools, they perform over 100 shows a year!
