



Our VBS Wish List ... **Can you donate any of these items?**

Help bring the high seas and the Bible stories of Peter, Paul, and the early Church alive for our children. You can **donate** these items or, if appropriate, **just let us borrow** them for the week of Mon., June 21, through Fri., June 25. You will help bring smiles to young children's faces! Drop off all items at the RE Office (door #6).

- Empty shoeboxes of any size (one needed for each child attending VBS)
- Clean, empty baby food jars, including the lid
- Empty toilet paper tubes
- Empty paper egg cartons (not the styrofoam kind, please)
- Telescopes, compasses, boat anchors, ships wheels, or other "high seas" instruments (decorative, toy, working, or otherwise)
- Captains hats, large bells, etc.
- Large and small stuffed animals or garden statues — dolphins, whales, pelicans, octopus (any "ocean" animal/fish)
- Animal slippers (any size, e.g., bunny slippers)
- Empty paper bags from Trader Joes or another grocery store
- A couple rolls of blue cellophane wrapping paper
- Hula hoops
- Solid-colored bed sheets (flat) of any color and size
- Throw rugs of any kind and size
- A couple of string mops
- Some planks of lumber (old, new, or otherwise but wide enough to walk on – no nails please)
- Gauze bandages of any kind and size
- Small, floating bathtub toys (e.g., boats, etc.)
- Small little toy people (e.g., Play Mobile or Lego people)
- Inflatable mattresses (any size)
- Jugs of apple juice or juice boxes (unopened and ready for quenching our thirst)
- VBS snacks (made at home and dropped off in the mornings of VBS on one or more mornings; we'll share a snack list with you! Example: one dozen 1-inch brownie squares)
