

Teacher Policies - Mrs. Doyle

Homework

Homework is generally given one night per week, due back the next day. Occasionally I will send home a family project that might take longer to complete, i.e. a 100-Day project.

Discipline

To help the children learn expected school behavior, children are given warnings for behavior missteps. Three warnings in one day result in that child getting a time out and a phone call to mom and dad. However, we always try redirecting unwanted behavior and praise for good behavior first.

Absenteeism

If a child is absent, the school office should be called before school begins. When the child returns to school, they should bring a note to the teacher explaining their absence. Extended absences/ vacation should be reported to the office, using the Extended Absence form, found in the parent handbook.

Homework

Absenteeism
